1. SA Government Funded - Domestic Students

Participant Course Fee - SA Government Subsidised Training

Eligible South Australian residents enrolled in Skills SA funded training are required to pay a Participant Course Fee (student contribution) of **\$0.50 per nominal hour**, unless an alternative fee has been specified by Skills SA. Eligibility for subsidised training is subject to the applicable Skills SA funding requirements, including residency, citizenship and visa eligibility criteria.

As a contracted Skills SA training provider, Fran Capelli Academy is required to collect the applicable Participant Course Fee and is not permitted to pay, reduce or waive this fee unless a Minister-approved exemption applies. Nominal hours are indicative and may vary based on unit selection and packaging rules.

Payment plans/instalments available

Payment plans are available to eligible students and may assist in spreading the cost of tuition over the duration of their enrolment. Students may make convenient monthly instalments towards their course fees, subject to an agreed payment arrangement. Students are encouraged to speak with the Student Services Team during the enrolment process to discuss a payment plan that best suit their individual circumstances.

The availability of a payment plan does not affect the requirement to pay the applicable Participant Course Fee (student contribution) for South Australian Government subsidised training.

4. Important Notice and Refund Summary

- All fees published by Fran Capelli Academy are accurate at the time of publication and are subject to periodic review. Course fees may be adjusted where required due to changes in government funding arrangements, student eligibility, course packaging, credit transfer, Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL), or other factors relevant to the enrolment.
- Access to South Australian Government subsidised training is subject to meeting the applicable Skills SA eligibility requirements. Prior to enrolment, applicants may be required to participate in the Upfront Assessment of Need (UAN) process/Pre-Training Review (PTR) and provide supporting documentation to verify their eligibility.
- For fee-for-service courses, any enrolment fee paid secures a place on the course and is generally non-refundable once enrolment has been accepted, except where otherwise required under legislation or specified in Fran Capelli Academy's Refund Policy.
- Where a tuition fee refund is approved, the refund will be calculated based on the units of competency that have not commenced at the time of withdrawal. The refund amount will be determined according to the nominal hours associated with those not commenced units. Units that have commenced or been completed are not eligible for a tuition fee refund. All refund requests must be submitted in writing and will be assessed in accordance with Fran Capelli Academy's Refund Policy and Procedure.
